**RE: Revised Pre-Hearing Timetable**

Please be advised that the Public Utilities Board ("PUB") has established a revised NFAT Review timetable for the remaining steps to be completed before the commencement of the oral portion of the hearing. The relevant changes, compared to the timetable previously set out in Board Order 127/13, are as follows:

- La Capra Associates and Morrison Park Advisers are provided with an extension until January 24, 2014 to file their reports (this extension was previously approved by the PUB).
- The PUB and Manitoba Hydro will have until February 4, 2014 to file Information Requests to La Capra Associates and Manitoba Hydro.
- Intervenors of Record will have until February 7, 2014 to file Information Requests to La Capra Associates and Manitoba Hydro.
- February 27, 2014 will be set aside as a hearing day in Winnipeg to receive Presenter submissions.

Currently, no community consultation sessions are scheduled to take place outside of Winnipeg, although the PUB may schedule such sessions in the future, given sufficient interest.
