### NOTICE OF DECISION

The Public Utilities Board (Board) has issued Order 9/22 which contains the substantive reasons for the Board's decisions in Order 137/21, issued December 24, 2021, in which the Board granted Manitoba Hydro a 3.6% interim increase in General Consumers Revenue, effective January 1, 2022, and Order 140/21, issued December 31, 2021, in which the Board approved the specific rates and rate increases for each customer class.

This interim revenue increase will be thoroughly reviewed in the General Rate Application process with an application to be filed by Manitoba Hydro in 2022.

The PUB is an independent, quasi-judicial administrative tribunal that has broad oversight and supervisory powers over public utilities and designated monopolies, as set out in statute. The PUB considers both the impact to customers and financial requirements of the utility in approving rates.
