Legal Fees

Byron Williams & Katrine Dilay (Public Interest Law Centre Legal Team)

This estimate is based on 24-35 hearing days and 2 days for workshops/technical conferences. In the event that the Public Utilities Board undertakes a deep dive into Manitoba Hydro's capital expenditures, the number of hearing days may increase beyond 35 days and this estimate may be adjusted accordingly.

Hours per hearing day for prior proceedings has been in the range of 20 hours and hours per day for workshops/technical conferences has been approximately 12 hours. The estimate of 20 hours per hearing day does not mean that counsel work 20 hours per day during the hearing. Rather, it means that based on many years of experience, legal counsel expects roughly 20 hours in preparation prior to the hearing, attending the hearing and preparing for argument. The estimate of time for legal counsel is highly dependant upon the number of actual hearing days, the nature of the proceeding and the provision of expert evidence.

In this estimate, we have allocated three quarters of the hours to Mr. Williams and one quarter of the hours to Ms. Dilay. The split of hours between Mr. Williams and Ms. Dilay may not reflect actual hours worked in this estimate, as hours billed for Ms. Dilay will focus primarily on discrete tasks, and will not include hours geared toward teaching and succession planning. We also note that there are some time efficiencies built into this estimate as legal counsel often prepares for cross-examination and attends the hearing at the same time.
