8. State reasons for the proposed intervention (please be specific).		
<p>In Manitoba Hydro's Cost of Service Methodology Review, GSS/GSM intervened to represent the interests of the small and medium-sized commercial users of electricity in Manitoba falling into the General Service Small and General Service Medium categories.</p> <p>The General Service Small customer class contains predominantly small commercial customers with loads of less than ~200kW. Further, this customer class is divided into two sub-categories: (i) Demand and (ii) Non-Demand. The latter customers pay a Demand rate based on the peak demand each month, in addition to a basic monthly charge and an energy (per kWh) charge.</p> <p>The General Service Medium customer class contains predominantly large commercial customers who use Manitoba Hydro-owned transformation assets exceeding ~200kW. GSS/GSM is again seeking to intervene on behalf of these two customer classes in the 2017/18 and 2018/19 General Rate Application.</p> <p>It is submitted that any decision made by the Public Utilities Board in these proceedings will very likely have a material impact on a significant amount of ratepayers that fall into the GSS/GSM customer class categories. Some of the issues that are of interest to GSS/GSM are: (i) the proposed rate increases, (ii) the need to ensure stable and predictable rate increases, (iii) key considerations or strategies that will seek to alleviate the potential rate-shock and the consequences that may flow to various customer classes; (iv) rate-design and the necessary considerations to ensure fairness in that exercise; (v) cross-subsidization of energy rates; (vi) DSM - the need to reduce promote energy efficiency; (vii) Debt management and the current challenges faced by the utility; (viii) Export revenues; and, (ix) Load forecast.</p> <p>The foregoing is without prejudice to GSS/GSM's final position on the full list of issues that will be in scope in these proceedings. In that regard, while striving to ensure continued inter-class collaboration and stakeholder engagement, GSS/GSM proposes to participate in Manitoba Hydro's 2017/18 and 2018/19 General Rate Application in order to ensure that the GSS/GSM customer classes are fairly represented and to assist the Public Utilities Board in understanding the views and positions of Manitoba Hydro's General Service Small Customers and General Service Medium Customers in respect of the Application and related matters.</p>
