Reminder Notice of Public Hearing

Applicant: Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation

HEARING:

The Public Utilities Board (Board) anticipates holding a public hearing of an application from Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation (MPI) for approval of rates and premiums for compulsory vehicle and driver insurance as of March 1, 2018. The hearing would take place at the Board's Hearing Room, 4th Floor, 330 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg, MB (commencing at 9:00 a.m.) on October 2, 2017.

RATE IMPACT:

MPI is requesting approval for Basic Autopac vehicle insurance rates and premiums effective March 1, 2018, which, if approved, will result in 2.7% increase in MPI's Basic vehicle premium revenue (in addition to the revenue impact of vehicle upgrades and an increased overall driver and vehicle population).

MPI proposes that the interest rate forecast for rate setting purposes be updated through a compliance filing process, using the actual interest rate on the 30th of November 2017, before 2018 policies are issued. Final approved rates would be established through a compliance filing to the General Rate Application process.

MPI is also proposing changes to driver premiums through the Driver Safety Rating (DSR) system, which are expected to increase driver premium revenue by \$17.5 million. The proposed driver premium increases only impact drivers on the demerit side of the DSR scale, and are structured such that no demerit driver will face an increase in their 2018/19 driver premium relative to what they paid in 2017/18, if they qualify to move up the DSR scale, with an 'incident free' year of driving in 2017/18.

Individual vehicle and driver premiums would vary depending on claim and driving experience, insurance use, territory and vehicle rate group. Full particulars, including the rate impact and application, can be found on the Manitoba Public Insurance website:

Interested parties should take note that the Board does not have jurisdiction over the MPI lines of business denoted as Extension or SRE, or as to MPI's Driver and Vehicle Licensing operation.

Persons seeking further information as to MPI's application, or with respect to the Board's process, may examine MPI's application and supporting materials on its website, or in the Board's office. Interested parties wishing to address the public hearing in French should notify the Board Secretary by **September 22, 2017**.

The Manitoba Ombudsman has recently issued privacy guidelines for administrative tribunals. The Board is mindful of its obligations under those guidelines. Its decisions in respect of the application being considered will be sensitive to the guidelines. Personal information will not be disclosed unless it is appropriate and necessary to do so. However, the Board advises participants that these proceedings are public and that as a result, personal information protections are reduced.
