RE: Response to Manitoba Hydro's June 9, 2021 Response to Order 53/21

This response is filed on behalf of the Assembly of Manitoba Chiefs (the "AMC") pursuant to the request of Associate Secretary Rachel McMillan dated June 18, 2021, providing all interveners of record an opportunity to file written submissions to address Manitoba Hydro's response to Order 53/21.

The AMC supports the Consumers Coalition's submissions filed on June 24, 2021, and requests that the PUB order a status update hearing. Given Manitoba Hydro's failure to comply with Order 53/21, no further delay should be permitted. Every delay amounts to another day that First Nations ratepayers continue to suffer from rate shock without sufficient regulatory oversight or review by the Public Utilities Board. A status update hearing process should be initiated as soon as possible.
