To our knowledge, no Canadian Private Insurers use the registered Owner model.

Private Insurers have a variety of models, most have some type of a hybrid model of Primary Driver/Listed Driver. Definitions of the listed driver differ between insurers including "usual", "occasional", "secondary", etc.

From what we can gather, they all have a declaration component.
