Motorcycle Major Class

Out of 18,000 motorcycles that are registered in Manitoba, how many of the registered owners don't have a licence that allows them to drive motorcycles?

RESPONSE:

Of the 18,080 units in major class 4, MPI removed 1,602 mopeds and 115 Corporate Customers that have motorcycles registered. Please note that mopeds are not included in the results since a class 6 license is not required to operate this vehicle. In addition, corporate customers are not included because no license would be shown for these customers.

That leaves 16,361 motorcycles, from which:

- 15,115 (or 92%) have a Class 6 driver's licence that allows them to drive a motorcycle.
- 1,245 (or 8%) do not have any type of driver's licence that allows them to drive a motorcycle.

MPI did not include class 6M status as eligible to drive a motorcycle since this class cannot operate a motorcycle outside of an approved motorcycle training course.
