**THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HANOVER

SEWER RATES
BY-LAW NO. 2016**

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Hanover serving Local Improvement District No. 4 (Mitchell) has applied to The Public Utilities Board for approval of By-law No. 2016 to revise the schedule of sewer rates of the said Municipality, and after public notice of the application - no persons signifying their desire to make representation in the matter;

AND WHEREAS the Board notes that the utility rate study which accompanied the application provided for a sum of money to be placed in a utility reserve account, and the Board therefore desires to ensure that these moneys be expended in an appropriate fashion;

AND WHEREAS the Board deems it expedient to do so;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. By-law No. 2016 of The Rural Municipality of Hanover serving Local Improvement District No. 4 (Mitchell) BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY APPROVED;
2. The sewer rates set forth in Schedule "A" hereto shall apply to all customers of the utility effective on the next billing in the normal course after the date of this Order;
3. This Order is subject to moneys being expended from the utility reserve fund only to support existing infrastructure, unless the Board has authorized the expenditure pursuant to Section 168 of The Municipal and Various Acts Amendment Act, c.58.
