



STITTCO UTILITIES MAN LTD. Proposed Non-Commodity Rate Revision Notice of Application

August 25, 2020

On July 10, 2020, Stittco Utilities Man Ltd. (Stittco) filed an application with the Manitoba Public Utilities Board (Board) along with an amendment on July 27, 2020 requesting a non-commodity rate decrease of approximately 8% effective November 1, 2020. Non-commodity rates recover costs incurred by Stittco for the distribution of propane to customers. The last rate adjustment to non-commodity base rates occurred for rates effective January 1, 2020 in accordance with Board Order 179/19.

Stittco's current and proposed non-commodity base rates are as follows:
